We need to focus on getting our membership back up. If anyone has any ideas on how we can do this, please bring them to the meeting. I wish health and happiness for everyone!



Club Liability Insurance Increasing This is a letter we received from SIA Headquarters regarding an increase in our liability insurance premiums.

April 13, 2021

Dear SIA USA Club Presidents and Treasurers,

In March we shared that we began the general club liability insurance renewal process with our broker, Pacific Ag. This insurance is in place to cover clubs in the event of accidents such as slips, trips, and falls, alcohol, and sexual molestation, as well as automobile use during club activities. This coverage represents the liability insurance fee charged each year on a per capita basis to members in the United States with SIA's dues renewal. Last year's renewal amount allowed SIA to maintain the prior fee of \$6.00 per capita.

As you are aware, 2020 was challenging, specifically with regard to maintaining comprehensive insurance coverage due to the COVID-19 pandemic and potential associated liabilities. As a result, the general club liability insurance will increase from \$6.00 to \$9.00 per capita effective club year 2021-2022.

A communication will be sent to club members in the United States on Thursday, April 15, 2021, but we wanted to inform you first.
