World Water Day is an awareness event that highlights the importance of having access to reliable fresh water. The Campaign Theme for this year is "Leave No One Behind". Today, billions of people are still living without safe water – their households, schools, workplaces, farms and factories struggling to survive and thrive. Marginalized groups – women, children, refugees, indigenous peoples, disabled people and many others – are often overlooked, and sometimes face discrimination, as they try to access and manage the safe water they need.

This isn't just an "over there" problem. Many Ohioans, even Muskingum County residents, do not have access to a public water source. In fact, 7 public water sources do not currently meet minimum drinking water quality standards.

Whoever you are, wherever you are, water is your human right. Access to water underpins public health and is therefore critical to sustainable development and a stable and prosperous world. We cannot move forward as a global society while so many people are living without safe water.


