They feel that they must succeed academically, socially and athletically. They feel that they absolutely have to get into the right college. They push them-

selves to the limit.

All you have to do is add other factors like sexuality and family issues such as divorce or finances and you have a recipe for disaster. 60 per cent of high school students recently surveyed indicated that they had thought about

suicide.

This is according to Robert Kennedy, Private Schools Expert.
