I think I can speak for everyone that she deserves some time off of the responsibilities to concentrate on her health!



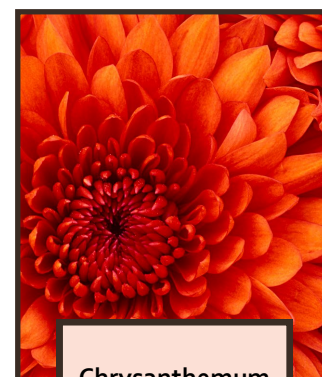
So, from all of us to you, Lynn, please take good care of yourself and we look forward to seeing you at the November meeting if you are able.
