## President's Letter—Lynn McGlade

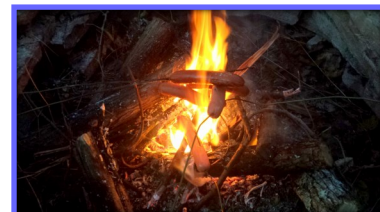
September already? Football games, wiener roasts, back to school events, and Fall colors... Oh my!

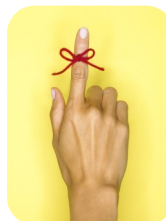
